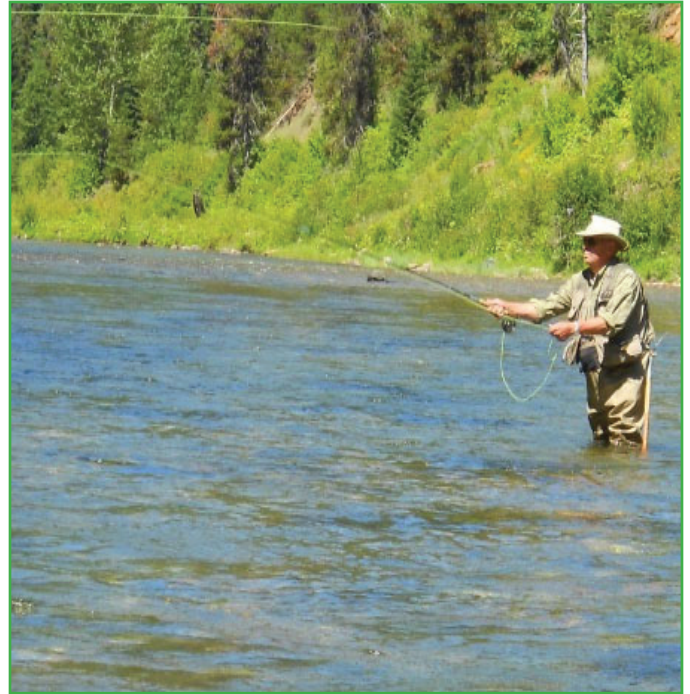


Clearwater Fly Casters Scholarship

Scholarship information:

Any undergraduate or graduate student involved with fishers research and management, natural resources management, fishing education or other work fostering the knowledge of fishing shall be eligible for the award.

Preference will be given to individuals who are involved with the conservation and restoration of wild fish, fisheries management and/or stream habitat restoration either through research, education, extension or include any aspect of fishing education.

Required:

A one-page NON TECHNICAL description of the proposed project with the appropriate contact information for the student and a letter of endorsement from your faculty advisor.

3. Documents in pdf format. Both project proposal and letter of referenc
